

HOUSTON INTER-CITY COUNCILS AND COURTS (HICC)
Lotto Raffle Rules and Guidelines

I. General Information

A. Purpose.

The purpose of the Lotto Raffle Rules and Guidelines is to insure that all participants are guided by the same rules and understanding as to how the Lotto Raffle is conducted and to insure that all participating know and understand the Lotto Raffle process.

II. Proceeds

- A.** All proceeds from the raffle will go toward MGB seed money (Operating Account).

III. Disclaimers

- A.** HICC or HICC MGB Lotto Committee cannot guarantee that any lotto ticket will be a winning ticket.

IV. Rules/Guidelines

- A.** The HICC Lotto Raffle will run from October 1, 2021 to February 12, 2022, the night of the MGB.
- B.** There will be two (2) lotto prizes. Each picture frame will be filled with a collage of Lotto chances. The first prize is a small picture frame with \$100.00 worth of lotto ticket chances. . The second prize is a large picture frame with \$150.00 worth of lotto ticket chances.
- C.** Each chance cost \$5.00. One book contains 10 chances worth \$50.00 per book
- D.** Two (2) books will be given to each Council and Court beginning after the St. Peter Claver Day Celebration in September. The GK/GL must sign for each Lotto ticket raffle book.
- E.** A date, time and place on the North and South sides to pass out the raffle books will be communicated to each Council and Court.
- F.** Each Council and Court is responsible for selling their books.
- G.** Each Council and Court must return the money and books for chances sold to HICC MGB Lotto Committee on count down night or the night of MGB.
- H.** Each Council and Court is responsible for unsold tickets. All unsold ticket must be return to HICC MGB Lotto Committee on count down night or the night of MGB.
- I.** The 1st and 2nd prize drawings will be held during the 2022 HICC Mardi Gras Ball night.
- J.** The winners must be returned the empty picture frames to Lotto Raffle Coordinator.
